The primary objective of the West Morris Regional District Interscholastic Athletic program is maximum student participation. However, there are two important principles which must be understood by all athletes.

FIRST Participation in athletics is a privilege granted by the Board of Education.

SECOND Along with that privilege and its benefits come certain responsibilities which every athlete must accept such as:

The athlete must recognize that the primary reason for attending school is to become a responsible educated citizen.

The athlete must strive to set a positive personal example at all times. The athlete must adhere to all school and community rules.

The athlete must strive to reach the limits of individual athletic ability.

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC RULES

I will not use any tobacco, alcohol, or other mind or mood altering substances.

I will obey all school rules.

I will conduct myself within the community in a manner which will bring credit to my sport and school.

I will obey all team rules established and announced by my coach.

PENALTIES

Mandatory:

First violation during a specific season of the smoking, alcohol, drug rule will result in a minimum of one week or not more than two game suspensions from the team.

Second violation of the smoking, alcohol, drug rule will result in expulsion from the team for the entire season.

Discretionary:

Violators of all other rules will be handled on an individual basis by the coach, Director of Athletics, Vice Principal or Principal.

REPORTING

It is understood and agreed by all coaches that a student violation reported by West Morris Regional faculty member, administrator, district administrator, or law enforcement officer will be accepted and acted upon as appropriate for the particular offense.

ADMINISTRATION

Every accused athlete has the right to be informed directly of the accusation; the right to offer an explanation; and the right to appeal the decision to the next higher authority.
